Lemons

Many years ago a person smugly quoted this saying as he gleefully recounted my hard earned money, "When life gives you lemons," he glibly decreed, "make lemonade." I thought, Is this the best answer you can give when you illegally deny my refund request? Personally, I feel circumstances dictate what you do with lemons and this, in my "humble" opinion, isn't the time to make lemonade. I encountered three problems as I considered this predicament. First, I don't like lemons. Second, I could think of some far more satisfying ways to use those lemons. Third, the Bible didn't condone any of my ideas on potential uses for the lemons. After a few sips of "lemonade," time in prayer, and repeated repentance, I decided to use this quote as an object lesson to show how God uses life's "lemons" to help His children grow. So, let's make some lemonade.

We'll start with lemons. Just mentioning the fruit may cause your mouth to pucker. Many people (myself included) tend to see lemons as something undesirable and associate them with unpleasant things we experience. Life's "lemons" may include sickness, financial failures, relational breakups, and various setbacks. Do lemons deserve their reputation? Are they as detrimental as we make them to be? Could it be that they are actually beneficial? Let's take a closer look. What makes a lemon sour? The answer: citric acid. Citric acid is found in the cells of all living creatures. Lemons are the top natural source for citric acid. Lemon juice has many uses. It is a natural insect repellent, a household cleaner, an antibacterial gargle, an antioxidant and a pain reliever. Lemons are high in potassium and vitamin C. Could it be that lemons and life's "lemons" are more beneficial than they are detrimental? If so, how can we get past the taste?

The next ingredient we'll consider is sugar. Why should we add sugar? Well, anyone who drinks pure lemon juice quickly realizes that it's not an endeavor for the faint of heart. Life's "lemons" are like this, too. Bitter, painful trials will become palatable only if we add other ingredients. What "sugar" has God provided for these situations? Let's scoop a cup of sugar from Romans 8:28-29, "And we know that God causes all things to work together for good

to those who love God,

to those who are called

according to His purpose. 29 For those whom He foreknew, <u>He also predestined to become conformed to the image of His Son, so that He would be the firstborn among many brethren"</u> (NLT). The sugar of God's purpose - using life's experiences to make us more like Christ - is an important ingredient in lemonade. Yet sugar does not complete the drink; we still are missing the most important ingredient.

Water is the main ingredient in lemonade. Lemon juice is sour, and sugar is sweet. When you mix 1 cup of juice, 1 cup of sugar, then dilute it with 5 cups of water, you have a refreshing drink. So it is with life. When we add liberal amounts of the "water" of God's promises to life's "lemons" and God's purpose, we have a "drink" that can benefit us spiritually.

In closing, everyone experiences varying degrees of difficulty. We can't avoid these lemons, but as we bring them to the cutting board of Jesus Christ, cut them with the knife of the Holy Spirit, press them with the press of the Holy Spirit, and strain the juice with the strainer

of God's Word, we are left with the most

beneficial ingredients. As we dilute the juice with God's promises and add the sugar of God's purpose, He wipes our tears and comforts our sorrows. While we cling to Him, He changes us to become more like Christ.

Vith the Helping People In Need (HPIN) Seminar 2016 in the rearview mirror, I thought a report from it and 3 of our most

recent seminars would be in order. The HPIN Seminar is a 3-day seminar, is jointly planned and presented by staff from Fresh Start Training Center and Deeper Life Ministries (DLM) the 3rd Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of January. On occasion we have invited a guest speaker to participate in presenting the topics. With DLM the host facility in 2016, we had approximately 100 persons in attendance. The day themes this year on day 1: "Created in the Image of God," day 2: "God's Design for Marriage," and day 3: "The Christian and Psychiatric Labels."

The Faithful Men Seminar was held at DLM on November 14th, 2015. Approximately 80 men participated in this seminar themed, "Pierce My Ear: Servant of the Living God."

The Faithful Women Seminar was also held near Plain City, OH on October 3rd, 2015. Approximately 190 ladies attended the presentations following the same theme as the men.

On August 7-9, 2015, approximately 125 single ladies gathered for the weekend at DLM for the annual Single Ladies Seminar for fellowship and listen to topics based on the same theme as the married men and ladies. We are grateful to all those who participate in the seminars by attendance, prayer, encouragement, and other behind-the-scenes work.


Shadow, The Barn Cat






