“Koinonia” Part II

In our last newsletter Willis Horst wrote about the koinonia, or fellowship, that believers have with God through the life, work, and death of Christ. As noted in that article, our koinonia with God is the basis for all of our koinonia—fellowship, relationship, and community—with people. We conclude this meditation with a few more thoughts on the body and blood of Christ.

Christians, we need to ponder and muse more on the facts of the dynamics of the body and blood of Jesus Christ. By faith we take part in the broken body and shed blood, and embrace the dynamics as fact and truth. The koinonia (participation) in His body and blood spiritually nourishes the heart and soul of the recipient, just as food nourishes the physical body. Our koinonia is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ. There is a spiritual link between the bread and the cup and the physical body and blood of Christ that these represent. In a spiritual sense, believers eat the broken body and drink the shed blood of Jesus Christ!

To understand the dynamics of His sacrifice for our sins, I would like to consider a few more biblical truths about His blood.

a) The Bible speaks of the blood’s unceasing existence.

The blood of Jesus Christ was real in the past, works in the present, and reaches into eternity. It is everlasting evidence of a finished sacrifice.

Scripture speaks of its present reality in Hebrews 10:19 and 1 John 1:7. It speaks of a future reality in Revelation 7:13-14.

b) The Bible speaks of the blood’s inestimable value.

What is the value of your redemption? What is the cost? By Peter’s estimate, it is more precious than gold and silver (1 Pet. 1:7). Jesus Christ laid down His life for His bride, the church, and purchased her with his own blood

(Acts 20:28b). Only the blood of Jesus, the sinless sacrifice, is deemed valuable enough to pay the price to redeem sinners from their sin. Oh, that we would believe, trust, and remember the staggering cost for redeeming sinners!

c) The Bible speaks of the blood’s indestructible bond.

Believers partaking in the blood and body of Christ do so by faith (1 Cor. 10:15-17; Cf. John 6:53). By faith, consume into the depth of your heart and soul the body and blood of Jesus, which is the complete and finished work for our salvation. This mutual participation

in Christ’s blood and body results in a koinonia (bond) with our redeemer Jesus Christ. We are “made nigh by the blood of Christ” and the body of Christ brings us into close relationship with other believers (Eph. 2:13).

d) The Bible speaks of the blood’s intercessory power.

Men talk about green power, diesel power, nuclear power, horse power, and such like. The Bible talks about blood power: a power that can never be overcome. This power defeated death, crushed Satan, withheld a legion of demons, and washes away sins. 1) It justifies (Rom 5:9—assures the imputation), 2) it reconciles (Col. 1:20—brought us into a relationship of peace with God), 3) it sanctifies (1 John 1:9), 4) it redeems (Eph. 1:7; Col 1:14), and, 5) it brings us to Glory (Rev. 12:11).

How do the people of God come to the place of Glory? Through the intercessory power of the blood of Christ: that is what brings the ransomed souls safely home at last! (Rev. 5:9-10; 7:14)

Let me share with you again the words of Horatius Bonar:

*Upon a life I did not live.
 Upon a death I did not die.
 Another’s life; another’s death
 I stake my whole eternity*

From the Desk of Dave Snyder




“Praise the LORD, for the LORD is good; sing praise to his name, for that is pleasant,” (Ps. 135:3 NIV).

We have been experiencing His goodness and are thankful for His continued provision. Following is a pressing need we are currently facing.

In May, DLM was notified that we need to replace our Fire Alarm System and were given 90 days to start the project. We contracted a local company to install the required system. We are estimating the project will cost \$ 13,000.00. DLM is in need of funds to complete this project. Pray with us that God may provide for this need.

UPDATE: We recently fixed some ongoing sewer problems at DLM. The repairs cost \$ 11,000.00. This has strained our finances. Pray that God will continue to provide for us as we minister to others.



LIFE IN THE WOODS




